What happened this month?:

On Feb. 16 at 5:30 PM the Southwest Working Group continued discussions on a plan for the Palomar, Industrial, Frontage area of the southwest at the south library on Orange. We continued to suggest a satellite campus for SWC for vacant lot on Palomar and lower density than 40 housing units per acre. The city wants high density housing there, and we want jobs.

On Feb. 17 the Park Master Plan and the Library Master Plan were presented to the public for comments. Most noteworthy is the recommendation that the Del Rey Library never be built. Instead a larger library at the Eastern Urban Core off of 125 is being called for.

The Heritage Museum on Third and Park will be open on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday thanks to donations and volunteers.
