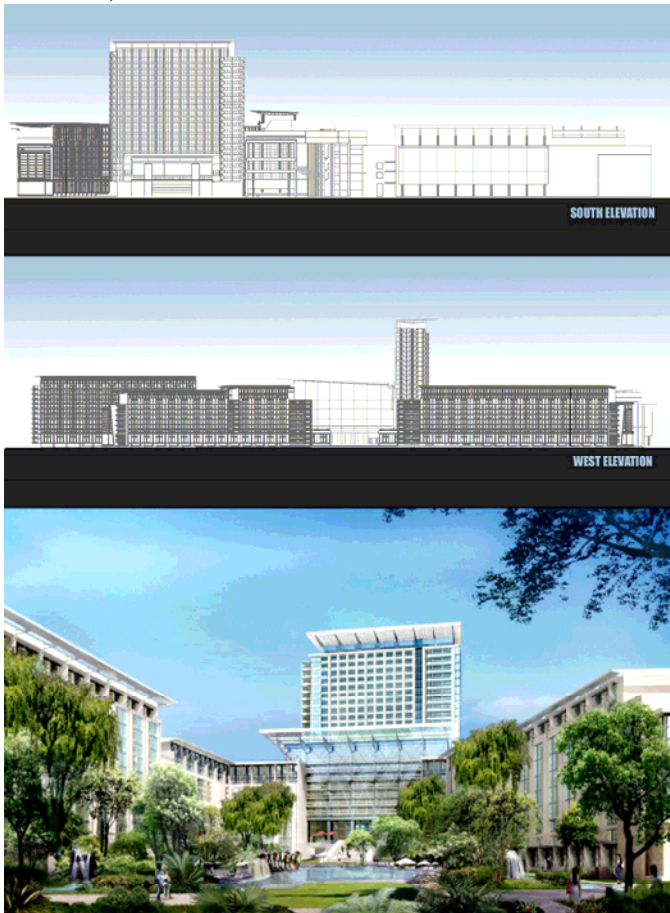

Leslie Wade, representing Gaylord Entertainment will discuss Gaylord's plans for the Chula Vista Bayfront and answer questions. They are planning a 2,000 room hotel and 415,000 square foot conference Center. This is an elevation picture from the Draft Environmental document. (The tower is 300 feet tall.):



On June 23 Allison Rolfe, representing Pacifica will also discuss Pacifica's 1500 condominium project and answer questions.



On Saturday June 21 11AM to 1 PM at Loma Verde Recreation Center (end of Loma Lane, off of Orange, first light east of Hilltop the city of Chula Vista will hold a Convention.

It is important that people come and participate in the discussions with the city. Mobile Home Park Residents need to make sure preserving Mobile Home Parks is written down as an important issue under Housing. Existing Businesses need to be included in Economic Development. Getting rid of the peaker plant needs to be a health issue, etc. There will be 3 sessions of small group discussion on: 1. Community Image/Safety & Health, 2. Housing, 3. Economic Development/Community Places, 4. Youth Community Resources, 5. Mobility & Safe Streets. (Separate Eng. & Sp. Groups.) We need to be represented in each group.
