Make comments on why our laws should cause this project to be denied or why air quality or health or other areas of expertise would indicate this is not the correct location. Brokers and/or appraisers are needed to

It is critical everyone call the council at 691-5044 again and INSIST that the council instruct staff to make it clear a heavy industrial use such as the MMC peaker 350 feet from homes and 40 feet from businesses violates a number of the city's laws. The city needs to tell the Energy Commission to deny this project in this location.
